# Availability

- Existing measures: whether measures to address the question are currently available
  - Yes, no, other notes
  - If no, could it be developed?
    - ✓ if it can be developed, what is recommended source, the estimated effort and realistic timeline to produce metric
- Data sources for measures: provide the data sources, e.g., data files and reports, for measures
  - Open text

# Feasibility

- Data access
  - public use files or reports, data use agreement required, state agency only
- Study population
  - Inclusion and exclusion criteria
  - Sample size and distribution across subpopulations of interest
- Data collection/reporting for measures
  - Mode of data collection
  - Frequency of data collection
    - Ongoing, monthly, quarterly, annually, biannually, no fixed schedule, others
  - Potential for trend or longitudinal analysis (has it been available for a while, will it continue to be available in a comparable form
    - ✓ Yes, no, unknown
- Data quality for measures
  - scale 1 (low) to 5 (high)

### Standards

- Measures derivation meets industry standards
  - Yes, no, unknown, industry standards unavailable
- Benchmarks are available for comparisons
  - Yes, no, unknown

#### Resources/Efforts

- Level of resources required to use identified measures to answer the question (level of effort may depend on whether answer to the Dada Availability above is yes or no)
  - Direct application, some transformation/revision, moderate transformation/revision, significant transformation/revision, new measures to be developed, or
  - Scale 1 (low) to 5 (high) with open text for estimated hours (if possible)
