
## Crisis Standards of Care Phase 2 Registration Survey Results

As of 2/12/2023


The registration survey results are a collection of responses from Community Advisory Board (CAB) and Technical Advisory Panel (TAP) members for Phase 2 of the Kansas Crisis Standards of Care. The survey was voluntary and collected information about professional affiliation and expertise as it pertains to the three topic areas in phase 2. There are 53 total members, 34 on the TAP and 19 on the CAB. Of those members, 48 survey responses were collected, 31 from TAP members, 17 from CAB members. 5 members did not complete the survey at the time of data export (02/12/23).


