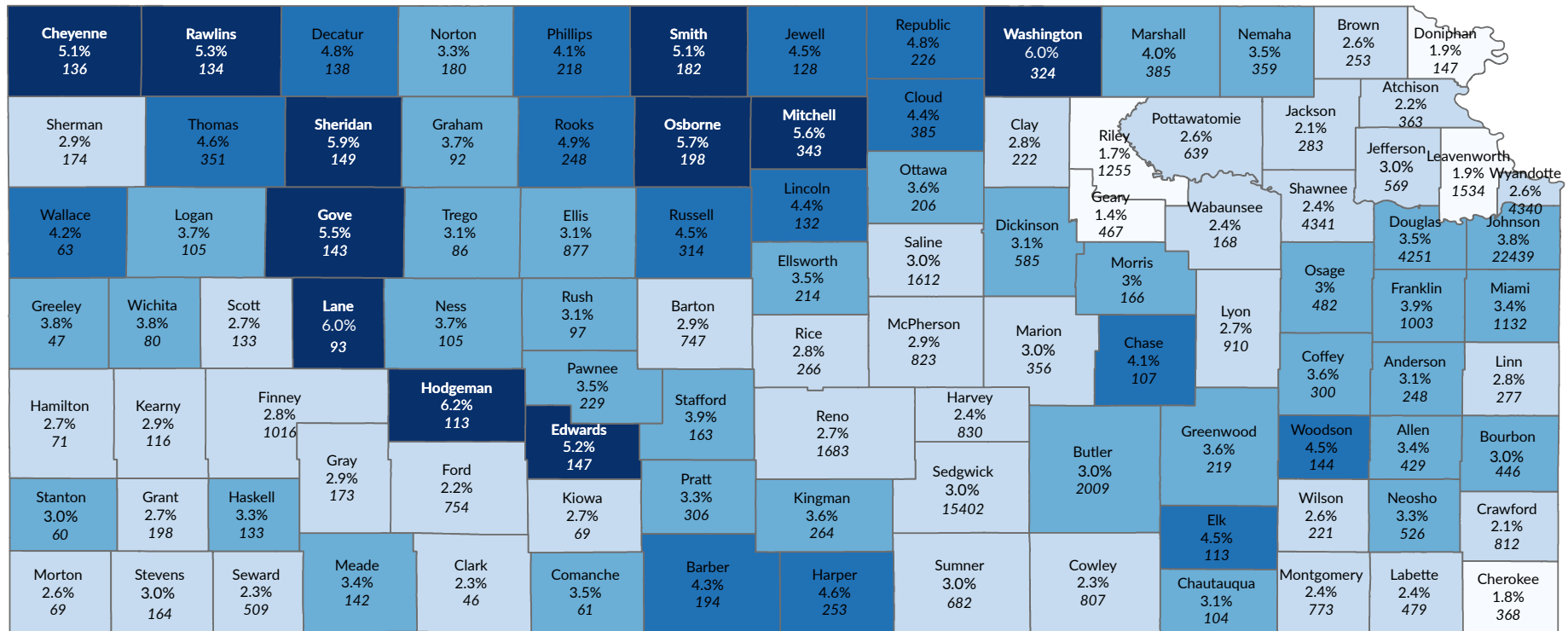




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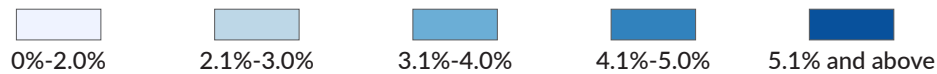
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Early 2021 Kansas Health Insurance Marketplace Plan Selections by County

Note: The U.S. Department of Health and Human Services released summary enrollment data on April 21, 2021, for the eighth open enrollment period of the federally facilitated health insurance marketplace created by the Affordable Care Act. The open enrollment period lasted from November 1, 2020, to December 15, 2020. During that time, a total of 88,627 Kansans selected a health insurance plan or were automatically re-enrolled for the 2021 plan year through the marketplace. Information is not yet available on how many Kansans have paid their premiums and are covered by the insurance plan they selected (effectuated enrollment). This data does not reflect plan selections made during the special enrollment period opened in response to the COVID-19 Public Health Emergency from February 15 to August 15, 2021.
