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
The Ruling

- The law was almost entirely upheld
- Medicaid expansion now “optional”
- Most significant changes slated for 2014
- Insurance provisions, delivery and payment reforms, public health focus

All Kansans: Approximately 2,751,000.




The Uninsured under the ACA

Income Level	Number	Impact of ACA
Over 400% of FPL	42,000	Ineligible for subsidies; may use exchange
133% - 400% FPL	158,000	Eligible for subsidies in the exchange
Less than 133% of FPL	151,000	Eligible for expanded Medicaid, if state adopts

State Action Toward Creating Health Insurance Exchanges, as of March 1, 2012




