SAHIE is the only source of single-year estimates of health insurance coverage for all counties in the U.S. SAHIE uses information from the American Community Survey (ACS), demographic population estimates, aggregated federal tax returns, records for the Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP). County Business Patterns, Medicaid, Children's Health Insurance Program (CHIP) records, and decennial Census to calculate estimates.
