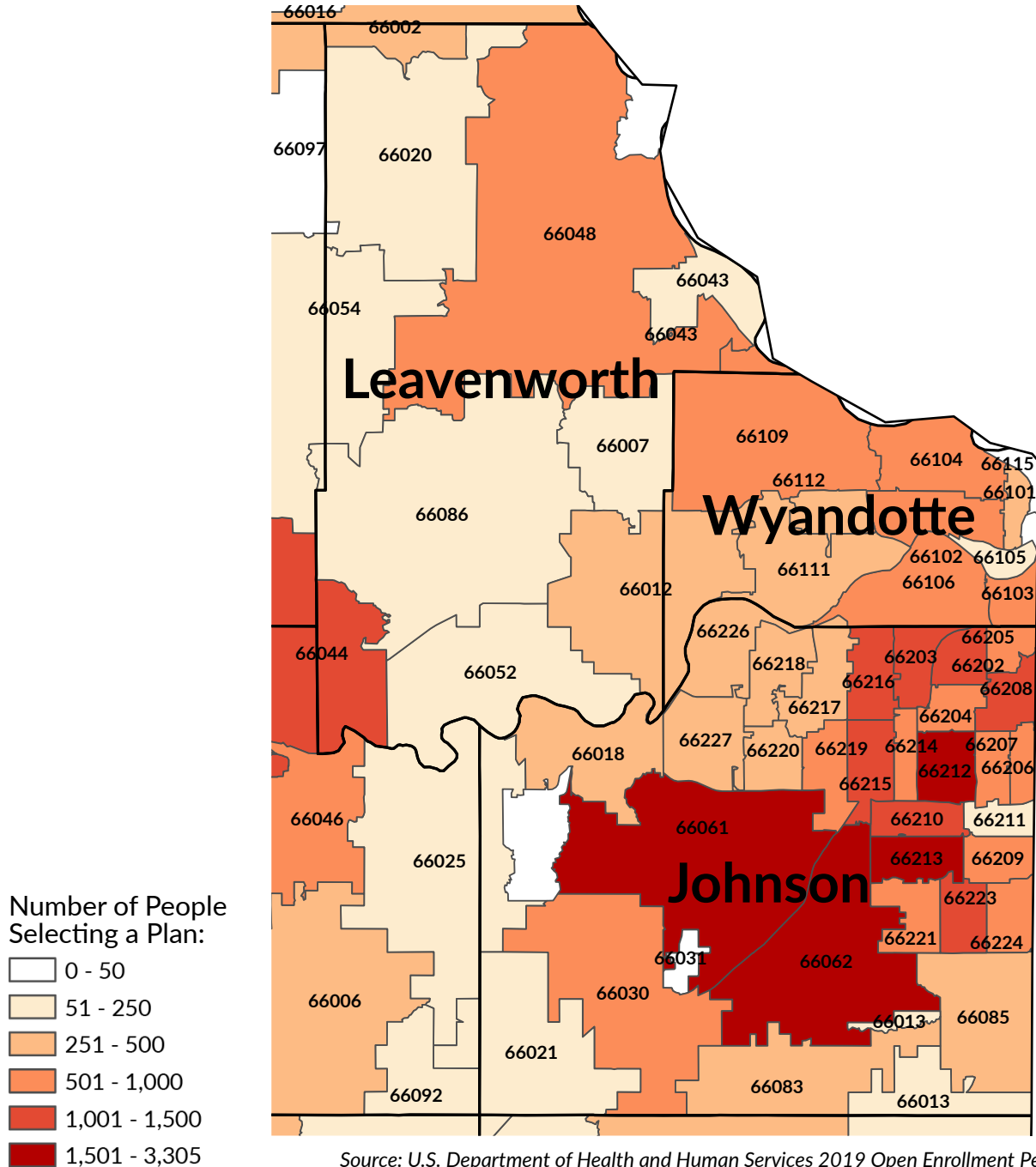


2019 Kansas Health Insurance Marketplace Plan Selections by ZIP Code: Johnson, Leavenworth and Wyandotte Counties

Note: The U.S. Department of Health and Human Services (HHS) released final summary enrollment data on March 25, 2019, for the sixth open enrollment period of the federally facilitated health insurance marketplace created by the Affordable Care Act (ACA).

The open enrollment period lasted from November 1, 2018, to December 15, 2018. During that time, a total of 23,069 people in Johnson County, 1,562 people in Leavenworth County and 4,682 people in Wyandotte County had selected a health insurance plan or had been automatically re-enrolled for the 2019 plan year through the marketplace. Information is not yet available on how many Kansans have paid their premiums and actually are covered by the insurance plans they selected (effectuated enrollment).
