




POPULATION CHANGE (%) FOR NON-HISPANIC WHITE KANSANS BY COUNTY, BETWEEN 2000 AND

### POPULATION CHANGE (%) FOR ALL MINORITIES BY COUNTY, BETWEEN 2000 AND 2016




### POPULATION PROJECTIONS BY AGE GROUP IN KANSAS, 2016-2066
















