Note: Children living in families with incomes less than or equal to 250 percent of the federal poverty level (\$61,500 for a family of four in 2017) were used as a proxy for those who may qualify for KanCare (Medicaid/CHIP).

Regions are designated using the Kansas Department of Health and Environment District Office Boundaries map.

The uninsured rate for children age 0-18 likely eligible for KanCare was calculated by taking the number of uninsured children likely eligible for KanCare and dividing by total number of children likely eligible for KanCare.

The Small Area Health Insurance Estimates (SAHIE) program was created to develop model-based estimates of health insurance coverage for counties and states. SAHIE is the only source of single-year estimates of health insurance coverage for all counties in the US. SAHIE uses information from the American Community Survey (ACS), demographic population estimates, aggregated federal tax returns, records for the Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP), County Business Patterns, Medicaid, Children's Health Insurance Program (CHIP) records, and decennial Census to calculate estimates.
