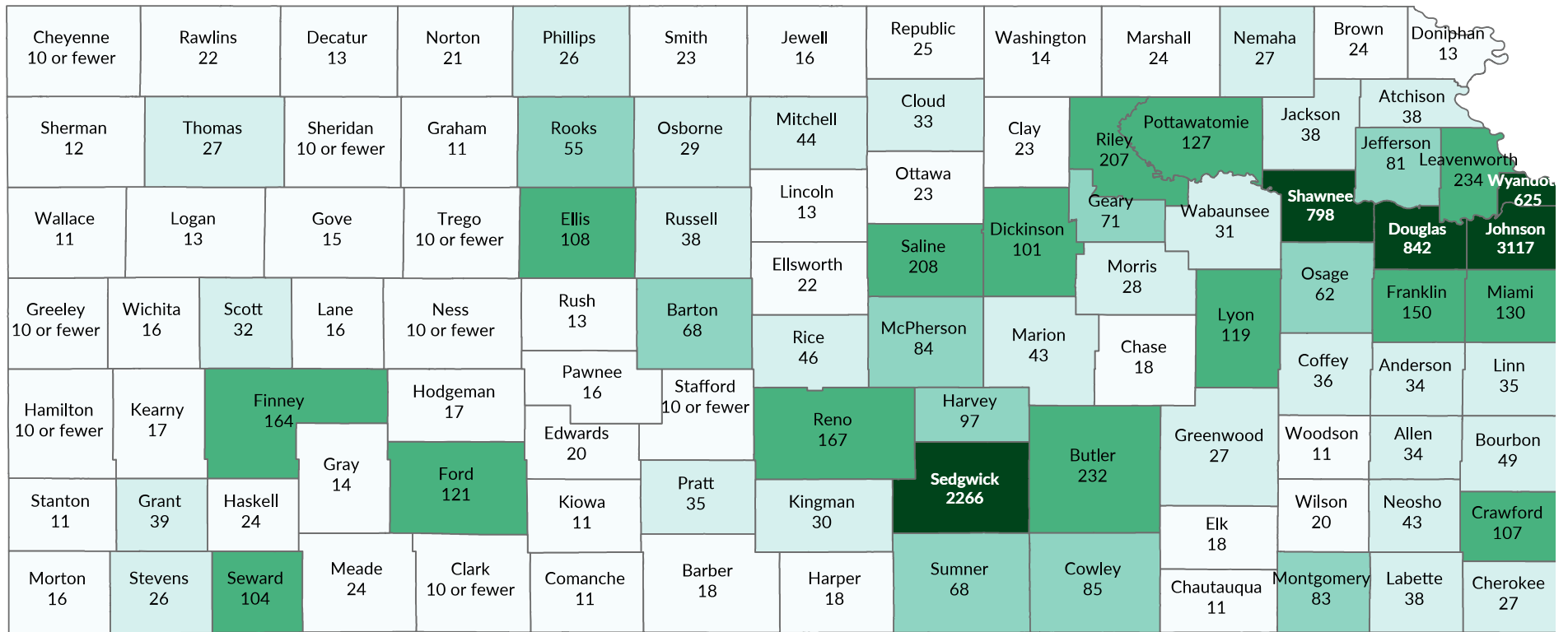




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Early 2021 Kansas Marketplace Dental Plan Selections by County

Note: The U.S. Department of Health and Human Services released summary enrollment data on April 21, 2021, for the eighth open enrollment period of the federally facilitated health insurance marketplace created by the Affordable Care Act. The open enrollment period lasted from November 1, 2020, to December 15, 2020. During that time, a total of 12,292 Kansans selected a standalone dental insurance plan for the 2021 plan year through the marketplace. The data report the count of unique consumers who selected or were automatically re-enrolled into a 2021 marketplace dental plan (regardless of whether the consumer paid the premium). This data does not reflect plan selections made during the special enrollment period opened in response to the COVID-19 Public Health Emergency from February 15 to August 15, 2021.
