Aetna has also collaborated with CVS -partner company, Omnicare, to better understand the role of the pharmacy provider in long term care facilities in auditing the medication of residents, specifically related to antipsychotic use. Aetna is also considering other initiatives to assist facilities in offering other successful alternatives.

As of June 1, 2020, United Healthcare Community Plan began monitoring antipsychotic use in elderly patients (ages 65 and older) with dementia that are utilizing antipsychotic medication without an FDA indicated diagnosis. UHC will notify the prescribing provider(s) via letter or fax, and further outreach may be taken to further assess the use of antipsychotics for members.

Presentation also included outreach measures taken to assess rationale for the use of antipsychotic drugs. Sunflower also conducts monthly outreach to Nursing Facility Medical Directors, Prescribers, MDS Coordinators, and Nursing Facility Directors of Nursing regarding the appropriate use of antipsychotic drugs for plan members.
