<p>Missouri Revised Statutes Chapter 198 Nursing Homes and Facilities August 28, 2020</p> <p>Citation of law. 198.003. Sections 198.003 to 198.186 shall be known and may be cited as the "Omnibus Nursing Home Act". (L. 1979 S.B. 328, et al. § 2)</p>	<p>Missouri</p>	<p>Facilities certified to participate in the Medicaid or Medicare programs shall pay a certification fee of up to \$1000 annually, payable on or before October first of each year.</p> <p>The amount remitted for the license fee, fee for amendments to a license, or certification fee shall be deposited in the state treasury to the credit of the "Nursing Facility Quality of Care Fund" which is hereby created.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ All investment earnings of the nursing facility quality of care fund shall be credited to such fund. ○ All moneys in the nursing facility quality of care fund shall, upon appropriation, be used by the department of health and senior services for conducting inspections and surveys and providing training and technical assistance to facilities licensed under the provisions of this chapter. <p>The department shall make at least two inspections per year, at least one of which shall be unannounced to the operator.</p>
<p>Department of Health and Human Services</p> <p>Office Of Inspector General</p> <p>"Nebraska did not always verify correction of deficiencies identified during surveys of nursing homes participating in medicare and Medicaid".</p> <p>Date: May 2018</p> <p>Report No. A-07-17-03224</p> <p>https://oig.hhs.gov/oas/reports/region7/71703224.pdf</p>	<p>Nebraska</p>	<p>What OIG Recommends:</p> <p>"We recommend that Nebraska revise its policies to</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (1) Require nursing homes to include evidence of correction with all submitted correction plans for deficiencies at or above the level of seriousness designated in Federal requirements and (2) Ensure that this evidence is retained by the State. <p>We also recommend that Nebraska maintain accessibility of, and the ability to read survey data documentation in accordance with changes in technology.</p> <p>Examples of deficiencies include a nursing home's failure to adhere to proper infection control measures or failure to provide necessary care and services.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (1) a statement describing the deficiency (2) a citation of the specific Federal participation requirement that was not met, and (3) a rating for the seriousness of the deficiency (deficiency rating: 1-5).
