- Emotional distress
- Other






Why is 988 important?

National Trend in Suicide Rates, 2000-2021

Suicide rates increased 37% between 2000-2018 and decreased 5% between 2018-2020. However, rates nearly returned to their peak in 2021.



In 2021:


One death by suicide about every 11 minutes

Nearly 900,000 youth age 12-17 and 1.7 million adults attempted suicide

Ranks (age-adjusted rate per 100,000 population)

- 30. lowa (17.5)
- 32. Missouri (18.7)
- 33. Kansas (19.4)

- 44. Oklahoma (22.1)
- 45. Colorado (22.8)
- 50. Wyoming (32.3)



Why is 988 important?


Overdose Deaths in Kansas

The median age in 2021 for overdose deaths was 40.

Kansas residents age 35-44 have a higher rate of overdose deaths than any other age group.








Received and Answered Calls and Received Texts and Chats, August 2022-July 2023






An average of 1,674 calls were received each month.

An average of 762 texts and chats were received each month.

In-State Answer Rate, August 2022-July 2023

The goal in Kansas is to maintain at least a 90 percent instate answer rate.






Average Speed of Answer, August 2022-July 2023 (Kansas versus National)

Average Speed of Answer (in seconds)

The average speed of answer is the average time a contact takes to be answered after listening to the automated greeting.


Kansas has remained at or below approximately 20 seconds for 7 out of 12 months, while nationally, ASA has not dropped below 30 seconds.





Rollover Rate of Calls to Backup Center, August 2022-July 2023






The rollover rate is the rate of calls that are not answered or abandoned instate and move to the backup center.

The rollover rate decreased almost 72 percent from August 2022 to July 2023.
