



Definitions



Artificial Intelligence (AI) refers to the development of computer systems that can perform tasks typically requiring human intelligence. These tasks include learning, problem-solving, decision-making and understanding natural language. AI systems can be classified into **Traditional AI**, which relies on predefined rules and algorithms for specific tasks, and **Generative AI (GenAI)**, which creates new content like text, images and music by learning patterns from vast amounts of data. Examples of GenAI include ChatGPT, Claude, Bard and MidJourney, among others.

Traditional AI:

- Rule-based, relies on predefined logic
- Deterministic and predictable
- Limited adaptability, requires manual updates

Generative AI:

- Learns patterns from large datasets
- Creative and generates new content (text, images, etc.)
- Dynamically adapts and improves with data

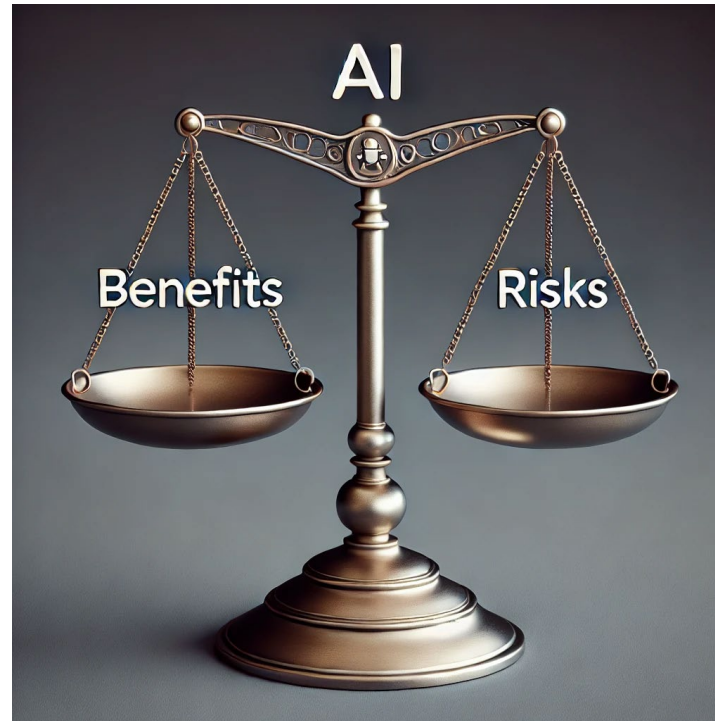
Why Is AI Conversation Timely?

- Increased innovation

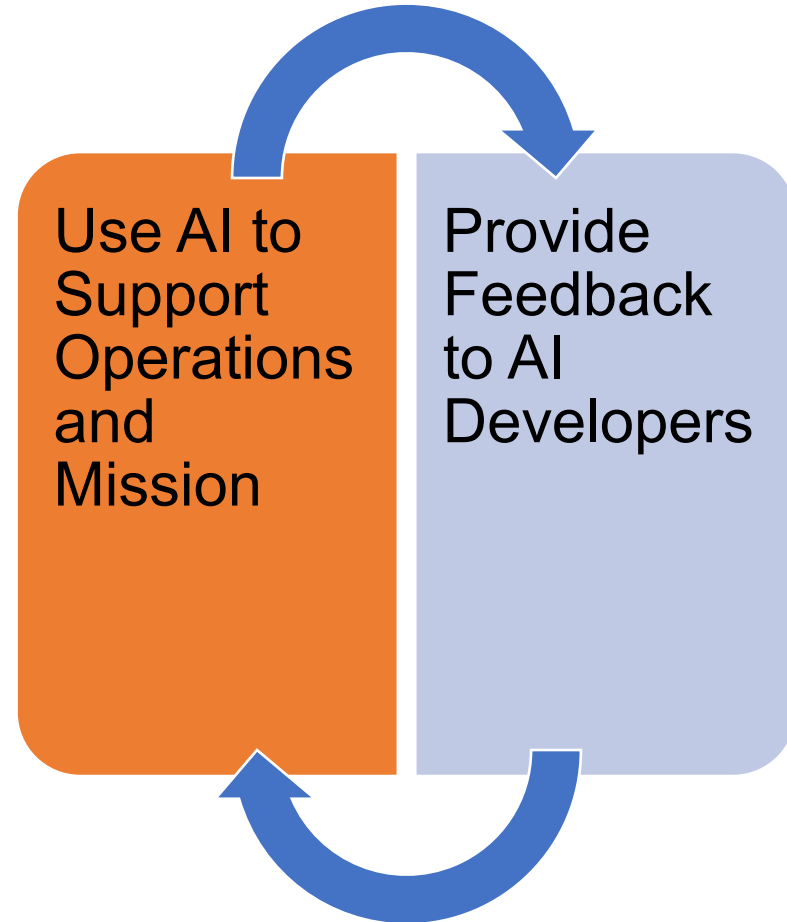


Concerns:

AI: Opportunity for a By-Directional Relationship



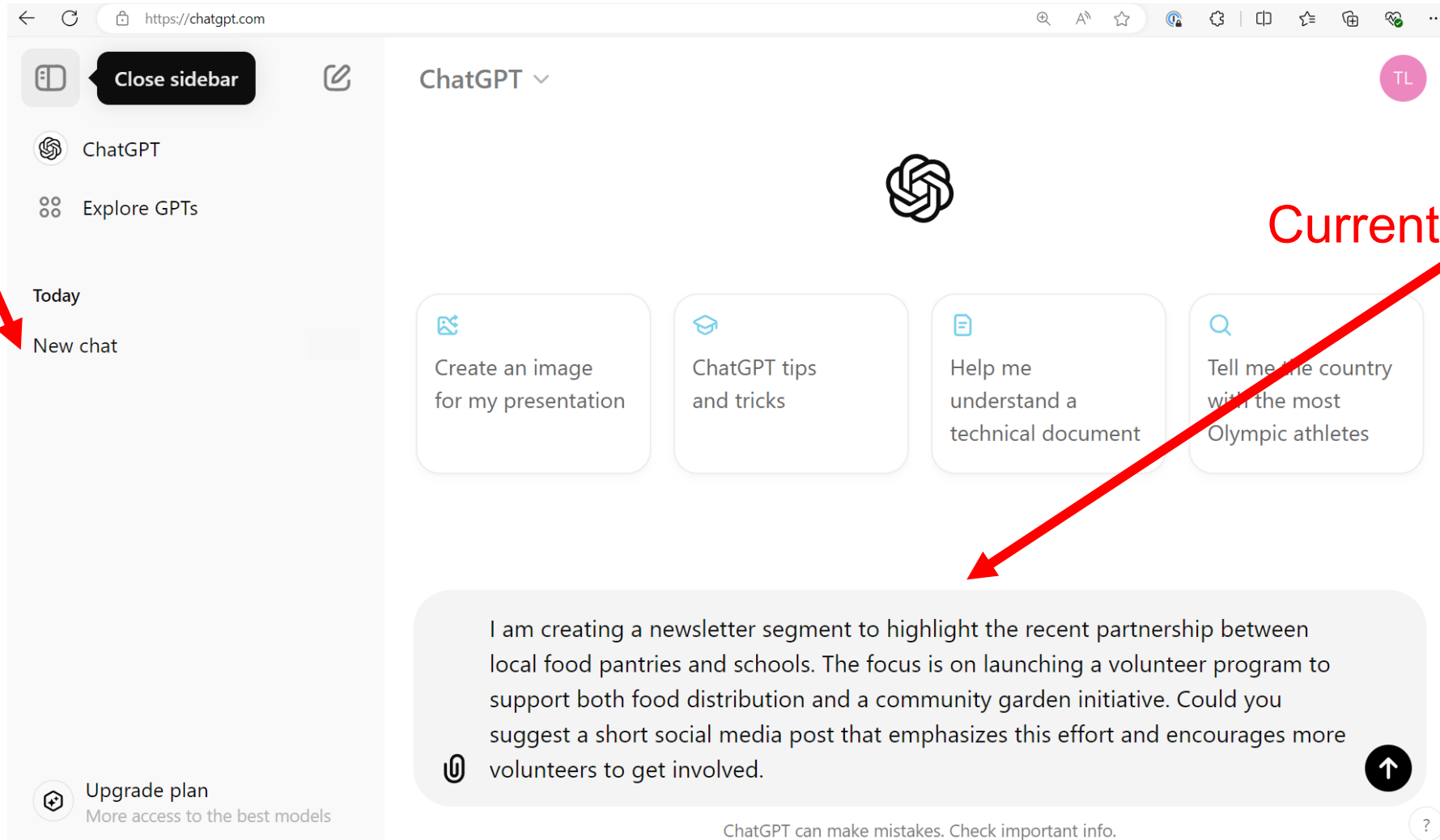

Tips for Successful Prompts



Query should include relevant context.



Incorporate specific keywords and terms to improve response relevance.



Specify the desired tone or style to shape responses accordingly.



Ensure prompts are neutral and unbiased to receive objective responses.



Continuously refine your prompts based on ChatGPT's responses.

Example: Content Creation and Marketing Cont.

Job Description and Recruitment Materials

Job Description: ChatGPT

- ☐ Generate an outline (new)
- ☐ Draft sections (new)
- ☐ Review and suggest areas for improvement
- ☐ Draft Q&A
- ☐ Draft recruitment ads
- ☐ Simulate applicant reactions
- ☐ Translate in other languages



Exploring GenAI: Key Questions for Effective Implementation

- What routine tasks could benefit from support using GenAI?
- Which of these tasks don't involve data privacy concerns or sensitive information?
- What is the level of AI literacy in our organization?
- Do we need AI guidelines? If yes, who should be part of the team to develop these guidelines?



Harnessing Generative AI Responsibly: Empowering Staff Without Undermining Skills

Avoiding Over-Reliance:

- Emphasize the importance of not relying solely on AI tools, and encourage staff to continue developing their core skills.

Promoting Critical Thinking:

- AI should be used to complement, not replace, human judgment and critical thinking.

Encouraging Continuous Learning:

- Review the outputs and work on them to challenge and improve their quality.
