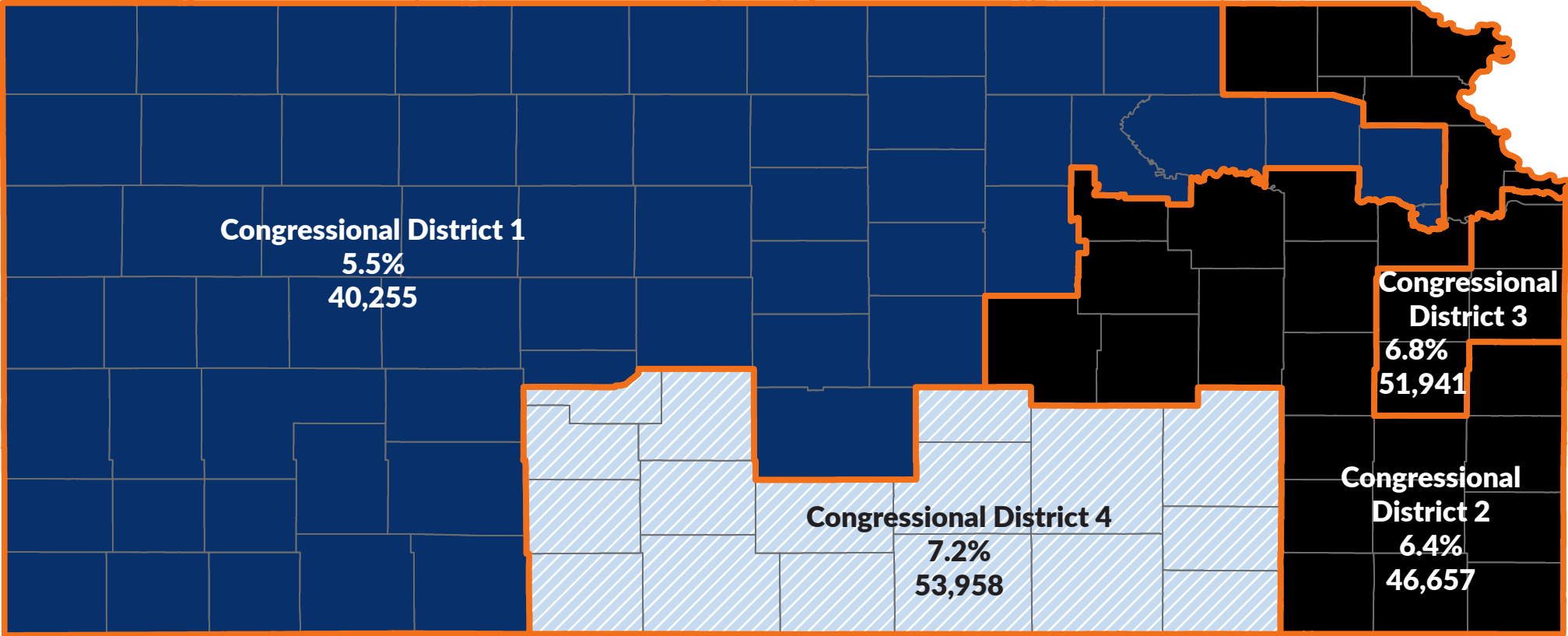


2026 Health Insurance Marketplace Enrollment by Congressional District

Note: The U.S. Department of Health and Human Services released summary enrollment data on March 27, 2026, for the thirteenth open enrollment period of the federally facilitated health insurance marketplace created by the Affordable Care Act (ACA). The open enrollment period lasted from Nov. 1, 2025, to Jan. 15, 2026. During that time, a total of 192,811 Kansans selected a health insurance plan or were automatically re-enrolled for the 2026 plan year through the marketplace. Enrollee data report the count of unique consumers who selected or were automatically re-enrolled into a 2026 marketplace health plan (regardless of whether the consumer paid the premium). In 2026, there were no Congressional Districts with less than 5.5 percent of the population selecting a plan.
